# Coding workshops for children in Europe and Africa









#### Orange participated to the code week 2015 with #SuperCoders in 9 Countries

- for children 10 to 13 years old, boys and girls,
- initiation to coding to create video animation/game on Scratch
- in 9 Orange countries, 4 in Europe (Spain, France, Poland and Romania) and 5 in Africa (Ivory Coast, Egypt, Mali, Senegal and Tunisia).
- with a common theme "Save the planet"
- with live exchanges via telepresence between children from the 9 different countries
- 1400 children participated to 60 workshops
- with the support of 400 Orange employees volunteers that were trained on the Sratch Platform to coach the children
- and with the support of associations: Simplon in Romania and France,
  Programamos in Spain and Akademii Małego Hakera (little hackers academy) in Poland



- 47 projects shared by children from France, Spain,
  Poland, Romania, Egypt and Mali,
- the most accomplished projects were presented at a side event of the COP 21 international conference in Paris

A game with camera to raise awareness on sorting wastes (Romania)




A game to raise awareness on reducing, recycling and reusing wastes (Spain)
