



DETECT AND REPORT CSAM IN CORPORATE NETWORK

Images classified by law enforcement as illegal




Image database installed in a server at the company Data agent installed in company computers The data agent detects material on hard drives, usb sticks etc.



At a hit, the system sends an alarm to Security Technical report is analysed by Security

Security contacts the police HR actions pending police investigation



The police verifies case and initiates investigation

FULL MANAGEMENT COMMITMENT NEEDED

Companies may trigger a "witch hunt" based on flawed evidence

Police may mis-qualify images as illegal

There is a "grey area" legally, in terms of age etc Managers can be put in uncomfortable situation through the monitoring of the employees

This is the same as spying on staff We can save a kid from abuse by recognizing and reporting it

No risk that family pictures are caught

The system is safe and effective and we follow national law

Unacceptable use of company equipment



COMMUNICATION

- Management commitment
- Discussion and explanation to employee organizations
- Intranet news about intention, describing the technology
- Intranet news about start, taking the child perspective
- Information on HR and Security intranet sites
- Public communication about our policy
- Readiness for media attention

"We want to explain to all employees that we do not tolerate this behavior, and why. We are talking about a serious crime and it is our responsibility to help the law enforcement in the fight against it."
